



- On the Bay Bridge, one lane of traffic will be closed on both eastbound and westbound I-80 from November 14-17, plus there will be controlled access to the bike and pedestrian path.
- Portions of various streets may also be temporarily blocked off as motorcades move through the city.
- Parking restrictions should be expected. All vehicles parked in violation of emergency no parking signs will be ticketed and towed. Restrictions will begin on Tuesday, Nov. 14, at 10 p.m. and extend through Saturday, Nov. 18.
- On-street parking will be unavailable within security zones.
- The Moscone Center Garage and Fifth and Mission/Yerba Buena Garage will be closed for the duration of the event. Public parking will remain available at other SFMTA garages.
- Travel predictions and third-party navigation apps may not display information properly during this period.
