

# Our COVID-19 Responses

To prepare for the surge of COVID-19 cases, Chinese Hospital had to redirect resources and postpone many elective surgeries and procedures. It was a difficult decision because we recognize the importance of receiving timely treatment and care for our patients and the community.

Now, we are safely resuming scheduled services and procedures at the hospital. Patients whose care was postponed are being contacted to schedule appointments. Chinatown is the second densest neighborhood in the U.S. As COVID-19 is primarily spread from person to person, testing is one of the keys to slowing the spread of COVID-19 and helps the community. Therefore, in collaboration with SFPDH and SRO owners, we build a testing and prevention program for San Francisco Chinatown SROs. The program offers COVID-19 testings for SRO tenants, and SFPDH will perform contact tracing if needed. As of 04/2022, we have served 30 SROs in Chinatown community. In collaboration with SFPDH, City and County of San Francisco and other community-based partners, Chinese Hospital offers COVID testings for San Francisco residents. In partnership with SFPDH, Chinese Hospital host a walk-in COVID-19 vaccination clinic at our Chinatown location. In an effort to provide convenient access to vaccination, our community clinics are also offering COVID-19 vaccinations. As of 4/1/2022, we have administered over 50,000 doses of vaccine to our communities, in accordance with state and local county guidelines.

Chinese Hospital looks forward to continuing to work with our local county and state partners to administer vaccines to our community as quickly as possible.
