Momentum Fund –COVID-19 Prevention and Management in 2021

Background

The COVID-19 global pandemic emerged in December 2019 and has since swept across the world, infecting more than 204 million people and killing over 4.6 million*. More than 665,000 have died in the United States and more than 67,000 in California. There are now almost 49,000 cases in San Francisco, and 603 deaths. Resources have been stretched thin. While there has been improvement, it has been uneven.



Chinese Hospital's Preparations and Early COVID Success

Chinese Hospital prepared for the pandemic before it arrived in the US. As a service to the Chinatown community and beyond, Chinese Hospital introduced a COVID-19 Prevention & Management Program, with inter-related services to stop an outbreak: public education, community-based testing, quarantine for those who need it with contact tracing, linking them to care and ultimately vaccination.

Together with our healthcare partners, Chinese Hospital was able to prevent a major COVID outbreak in congested Chinatown. Chinese Hospital earned national and local recognition from the New York Times, the PBS NewsHour, CNN, the San Francisco Chronicle, and KPIX5, as well as Sing Tao Daily, World Journal, China Press, and KTSF. That work continues, as urgently as ever.

How Faithful and New Donors Make a Difference Fighting COVID

During the pandemic, donors Keith Tsu and Carmelita Ko gave \$1 million to open Chinese Hospital's second floor to overflow patients from Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital, while donor Arthur Chan gave \$500,000 to reconfigure the Hospital's Cancer Clinic. The Herbst Foundation gave \$250,000 to pay for the reconfiguration of the Hospital's blood draw clinic, ensuring patient safety.

Among others, the Stupski Foundation distinguished itself by providing immediate and long-term funding, underwriting a \$250,000 mobile COVID testing tent to be deployed among 105 Single Room Occupancy Hotels, while developing the Hospital's capacity to serve frail elderly in later life.

Hundreds of new donors have stepped up to help Chinese Hospital cope with the worsening pandemic. Some have been enticed by donor impact, Chinese Hospital's Platinum Seal of Transparency and 100% accountability rating. Even with that support, a fourth COVID surge has forced Bay Area communities to reintroduce protective measures such as masking, testing, and distancing. Chinese Hospital needs your help to do our part.
