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LumiQuick Diagnostics, Inc. supports Chinese Hospital's COVID-19 response with 210,000 rapid test kits

SAN FRANCISCO, CA — Chinese Hospital received 210,000 FDA EUA authorized Boson™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Test Cards from LumiQuick Diagnostics, Inc. (LumiQuick) last week. It is the single largest donation of medical supplies Chinese Hospital has received since the COVID-19 pandemic broke out in 2020. LumiQuick is the official representative of Boson™ Biotech Co. Ltd. in the U.S.

Vaccination offers solid protection against severe COVID-19 outcomes, but rapid and easy access to testing is essential to curb the spread of the virus in this new phase. As the underserved communities are at higher risk of hospitalization and death from COVID-19 and often left behind with fewer preventative resources, Chinese Hospital will distribute these rapid test kits to the those in need in San Francisco Bay Area together with its community partners, including CCHP, Supervisor Aaron Peskin's office, Supervisor Gordon Mar's office, San Francisco Sheriff's Department, Consulate-General of China in San Francisco, On Lok, Self-Help for the Elderly, Community Youth Center of San Francisco, API Council, Sam Yup Benevolent Association, and Chinese Christian Union of San Francisco.

"LumiQuick is pleased to donate over one million Boson™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Tests to San Francisco Chinese Hospital, Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, and AHMC Seton Medical Center. These are community partners who are best equipped to get the test kits in the hands of people who need them." said Charles Yu, the CEO of LumiQuick, "With the rising of COVID-19 cases nationwide and the continuous mutation of the virus, the regular testing is playing an important role to help people to protect themselves and prevent the spreading of this contagious disease. Coming of new school year, we can foresee the increased chances of COVID-19 infection. We hope that our donation will help the school and community to make the tests more available for people in need. To continue to recover the economics from the pandemic, we need a healthier community. We are proud that LumiQuick can make this contribution and will continue to support our community."

The cornerstone to preventing transmission of COVID-19 is testing, and the key factor in fighting the pandemic is partnership. Since the pandemic started, Chinese Hospital has pulled the community together to combat COVID-19, as well as denounced the related hate crimes against Asian Americans. About the BOSON™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Test Card

Boson™ Rapid SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Test Card is a lateral flow immunoassay intended for the qualitative detection of nucleocapsid protein antigen from SARS-CoV-2. This test is authorized for non-prescription home use with self-collected anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 14 years or older



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when tested twice over three days with at least 24 hours (and no more than 48 hours) between tests. The test is authorized for individuals with symptoms of COVID-19 within the first 6 days of symptom onset, or without symptoms or other epidemiological reasons to suspect COVID-19.

This test is also intended for non-prescription home use with adult-collected anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 2 years or older when tested twice over three days with at least 24 hours (and no more than 48 hours) between tests. The test is authorized for individuals aged 2 years and older with symptoms of COVID-19 within the first 6 days of symptom onset, or individuals without symptoms or other epidemiological reasons to suspect COVID-19.
